Covering around 50,000 m<sup>2</sup>, the trade fair duo presents the entire value chain of the wood industry, from forestry and sawmill technology to bioenergy, logistics, timber construction, joinery supplies and carpentry equipment.

The trade fair offers a compact market overview, showcases current developments and provides the ideal setting for professional exchange, new contacts and successful cooperation within the forestry and wood industry across Central and Southern Europe.

## SAWMILL TECHNOLOGY & INNOVATIONS

This area presents the sawmill industry with its latest technologies, solutions and developments. Visitors will find leading suppliers in the fields of sawmill technology and wood drying, as well as solutions for forest stand management, forest area administration, timber harvesting technology, timber measurement and IT systems. The section is complemented by research, education, consulting, training and further education opportunities.



The Innovation Area provides space for new ideas, innovative solutions and current developments in the wood industry.

Suppliers, start-ups, makers and research institutions present their approaches, products and future-oriented topics. Lectures and live presentations complement the area and offer additional insights into new technologies and developments within the industry.





## HALL 2 **MOBILE SAWMILLS, BIOENERGY**

This area focuses on practical solutions relating to bioenergy and mobile sawmill technology. Visitors can discover various energy sources, small-scale power plants, screening and shredding technology, as well as modern combustion and environmental technology. A special highlight is the presentation of mobile sawmills in full operation on site, allowing visitors to experience the technology directly in action.



**HALL 3 MEETING POINT HUNTING & FORESTRY****HUNTING**

With its focus on hunting, the trade fair expands its offering to include a practical area dedicated to hunting and outdoor topics. The range extends from binoculars and target optics to hunting equipment and hunting clothing. Associations and off-road vehicles are also represented in this area.

**FORESTRY**

Forestry is one of the largest exhibition areas of the trade fair and forms one of its central focal points. The range extends from timber harvesting and cable crane technology to reforestation, forestry and safety clothing, as well as forestry tools. This area therefore provides a broad overview of current products, solutions and developments in forestry.



**HALL 4** **TRANSPORT & LOGISTICS**

Efficient timber trade requires high-performance solutions in transport and logistics. In Hall 4, exhibitors present their products and services in the fields of storage and transport technology, as well as further systems and services along the logistics chain. The range extends from forklifts and handling equipment to storage technology, IT networks and services for road, rail and waterway transport.

**HALL 5** **HOLZ&BAU**

HOLZ&BAU brings together key products, solutions and services related to building with wood. The range extends from joinery supplies and equipment to hand-held machinery, timber construction software, timber construction systems, wood-based materials, fastening technologies and vocational school programmes. This area provides a broad overview of current topics and developments in timber construction.

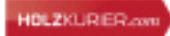

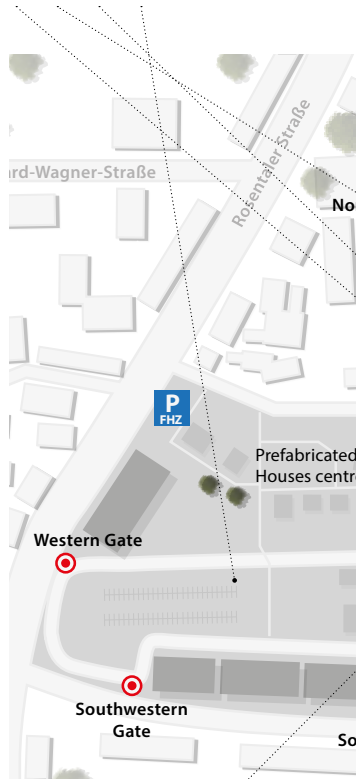

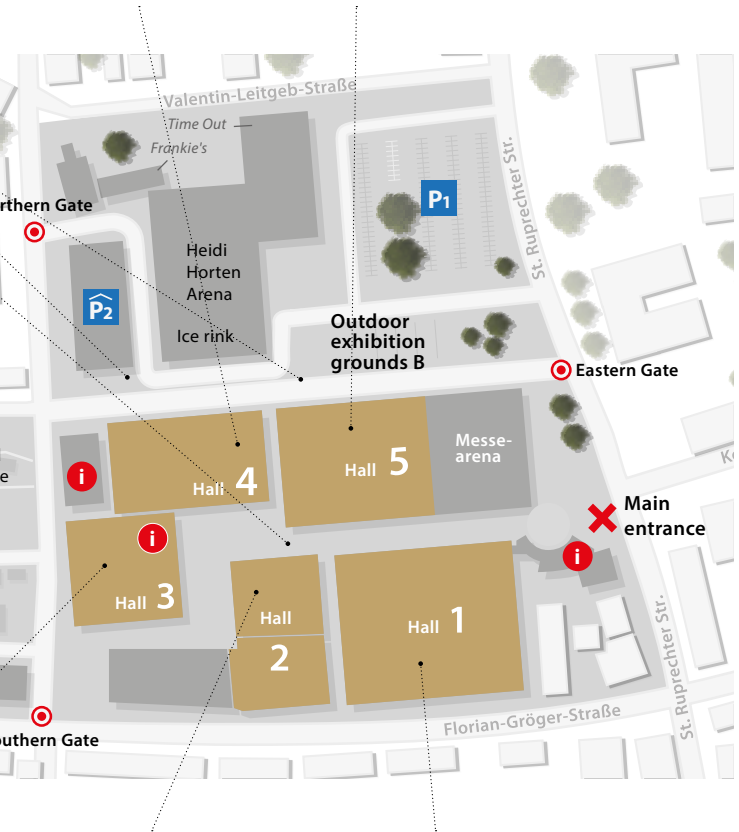
